

Uniform Policy

It is the policy of Dromana College that **all students must wear school uniform**. Approved by the College Council, this is in keeping with our aim of developing in students a feeling of belonging and a sense of identity. The positive image that the College presents to the community is given high priority. Students must wear the uniform on each school day and when on a school excursion and the uniform must be presentable at all times. If this is not possible, students must bring a note to their Head of Year, before Form Meeting, who will arrange an Out of Uniform pass. There are a series of consequences for students who are repeatedly out of uniform without a valid reason and students may be sent home. The costs of the uniform have been kept as low as possible and the uniform has been designed for easy maintenance, student comfort and protection.

An important part of the uniform is the leather shoes. **Sport, surf and skate shoes and boots are NOT ACCEPTABLE.** Proper foot covering provides necessary safety. Sport footwear is only to be worn for Sport or Physical Education. All students will be working in practical workshops and laboratories with a variety of tools and equipment. Approved protective clothing and footwear must be worn in all workshops and laboratories. The wearing of ear muffs in the practical area has been advocated because of noise levels whilst classes are in progress.

For safety reasons students may wear a watch and a stud or small sleeper earrings in the ears only and body piercing on any other visible part of the body is not permitted. Extreme hair styles and makeup colours and are not permitted. Hair colours and make up/sun protection should be a natural tone.

It is expected that students will be neat and tidy and will observe standards of cleanliness acceptable to the College. All items of clothing must have the Dromana College logo attached.

Dromana College is a SunSmart School and students are required to wear a hat when outside during Terms 1 and 4. In keeping with College values, it is expected that students will take responsibility regarding SunSmart behaviour.

The College logo is required to be on all items of the Dromana College uniform and please ensure all items of clothing are named.

All uniform items must be purchased from the Dromana College Uniform Shop with the exception of shoes, socks and tights.

The College Uniform Shop will also be opened during peak times as required including Year 6 to 7 Information Evening (in November), Year 6 to 7 Orientation Day, (in December) and Notebook Collection Day, (in January).
